Housing at our Terrace campus is convenient, offers excellent value, and provides an alcohol and smoke- free environment conducive to learning.

Once we receive your application, we will either offer you a space in Housing or the option to be placed on a waitlist for space as soon a spot becomes available. Upon acceptance to Housing, you are required to follow a payment scheduled for the non-refundable Application Fee and Damage Deposit. Once payment has been completed, your room assignment will be confirmed by email.

For Payments

For the following payment options, we accept Visa, MasterCard or American Express. Please note that Visa debit is not accepted.

- Online Banking if you have a Canadian bank account (Scotia, RBC, BMO, TD, CIBC)
 - Online Banking
 - Select "Pay Bills"
 - Select "Set up a payment."
 - Enter the payee. Add Coast Mountain College as the payee.
 - Amount \$.
 - Account: Use your student number as the account number (e.g.0012345)
 - And the frequency from the drop-down menu.
 - Select "Next," then select "Set Up Payments."

Your application fee, damage deposit and first month's rent must be paid BEFORE you can check-in. Check-in hours are Monday to Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Intake into the dorms **MUST** be during regular office hours.

Housing access depends on completing an intake process with the Student Housing Coordinator and having your picture taken and a Student ID created. Your student ID is also your key for accessing the dorms, and this setup can only take place Monday to Friday, between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

The main building has three floors and two wings on each floor. Each wing has a shared kitchen. The kitchens are supplied with fridges, stoves and microwaves.

**Students are not allowed to bring personal fridges or cooking appliances. For example, no hotplates, slow cookers, toasters, burger makers etc. All students living in Housing are responsible for cleaning their room and the shared kitchen area, and the shared spaces within the units such as the kitchenette, bathroom, living area, and storage. Cleaning must be completed at the time of cooking.
